

BORDER FISHERY FISHERY AND MATCH RULES



- Guests must book in before starting to fish and be in possession of an EA Rod License.
- All anglers must have a current E.A rod License.
- Anyone under 16 must be accompanied by an adult and not left unsupervised unless a member of our Junior Club.
- Visitor's dogs are allowed on the fishery, but must be kept under control and any waste to be cleaned up and placed in the rubbish bins provided.
- Vehicles/cycles must be left on the car parks (not on the grass) and are left entirely at your own risk
- All members must display a B.M.A.C car sticker in their vehicle.
- The management will not be held responsible for loss of tackle, personal injury or damage to cars.
- Fishing is only allowed off pegs provided.
- No stoves, no cooking, no bad language.
- Radios can only be used with earpieces.
- Toilets are provided. Please use them rather than fouling the environment.
- No tins allowed on the banks of the fishery.
- All litter must be taken and put in the rubbish bins provided.
- A fisherman will be held responsible for any litter on/near his peg unless he has notified the management of previous abuse.
- No fish may be taken from the fishery nor be brought to the fishery (dead or alive).
- Anyone caught stealing will be prosecuted.
- Any accident or injury that takes place on the fishery must be reported to a member of staff and logged in the Accident Book.
- Barbless hooks only, max size 12's. Note: a barbed hook with the barb 'pinched in' is not allowed.
- No feeder floats allowed of any description.
- No rattlers, floating pole of any description allowed.
- Minimum hook length is 4 inches.
- No braided lines, braided hook lengths or fixed leads and all feeders, whether swim or method, must be free running and able to break free should a fish become snagged. The Guru x-safe system is allowed
- Only one rod or pole to be in use at a time and must not be left unattended.
- All nets must be air dried before any match and not placed in the water until a maximum 15 minutes before the all in.
- All fish over 4 ounces must be landed using a landing net.
- Keep nets are only allowed during matches with a maximum of 60lbs per net.
- Anglers must use two or more keep nets, fish 3lbs & under +silver fish in one net, fish over 3lbs in your second/third net.
- The limit of an angler's peg is the nearest edge of the platform on the adjacent peg when that peg is free or when the peg is used, the midpoint between the two platforms.
- Any angler with litter (including cigarette ends) on or around their peg will not be weighed in.
- Anglers can use their preferred soft hooker pellet but any hook bait must be used at a sensible level.
- All feed pellets must be purchased from our fishery shop.
- Baits banned for feeding are trout pellets, boilies, peanuts, tiger nuts, chick peas, pet food, macaroni cheese, bloodworms, jokers and surface floating baits of any description.
- Banned hook baits are, peanuts, tiger nuts, chick peas, pet food, bloodworms, jokers and surface floating baits of any description.
- Ground bait can only be used in method feeders, cage feeders or pole cups up to a maximum of 1kg.
- Any unused bait must not be thrown into the water or on the bank after fishing.
- Anyone breaking these rules will be made to leave immediately without any refund.

Please respect and adhere to all rules as spot checks will be exercised on the banks.
