

BAY MALTON ANGLING CLUB BORDER FISHERY - MEMBER RULES

- 01 Keep nets are banned
- 02 Strictly barbless hooks only. Maximum hook size 14's - 10's on Stacey's Pool and Specimen Lake.
- 03 All landing nets must be dipped.
- 04 Small flat method feeder may be used on Stacey's Pool the Match Lake and Specimen Pool.
- 05 No double hooking.
- 06 No floating poles or rattlers of any description.
- 07 All fish over 4 oz must be landed by net.
- 08 Any member with litter around their peg will be held responsible for it. Includes cigarette ends.
- 09 No corn or meat tins allowed on the fishery banks and all bait must be kept in bait boxes.
- 10 No braided lines to be used.
- 11 Unused bait must not be thrown into the water or onto the bank after fishing.
- 12 Gates must be kept locked unless there is match on. See notices on the gate.
- 13 All members must leave the fishery one hour after sunset, or on phase one, 6.30 am till 9.30 pm Summer only.
- 14 All members must have a current E.A. Rod licence.
- 15 All junior members under the age of 16 must be accompanied and fully supervised by a senior member or parent who will be bound by club rules.
- 16 Only one rod to be used at one time.kkkkkk
- 17 No baited rods or poles to be left unattended in

water.

- 18 Only 1 kilo of ground bait allowed for feeder or pole pot and small flat method feeder.

19 BAIT BANS

No boilies, nuts, peas, beans, bloodworm or jokers. No cat or dog meat. Only fishery Carp pellets can be used as feed. Carp pellets are sold on site.

FLOATING BAITS

Floating baits or pop up baits are now banned

Any member found to be breaking any of these rules will be expelled from BMAC angling club.
