

# River Dane, Manor Farm



[A] on the map above, is the end of the Cotton Hall Farm stretch of the River Dane. Access is over the stile marked, bringing you onto the Manor Farm length of the Dane. Access can also be gained from the lay-by on the Middlewhich Road and using the public footpath. Be warned this is a fair trek so travel light and, obviously, your car is not as securely parked as leaving it on the Cotton Farm length. Neither is the walk as long as from Cotton Farm.

**Description.** The length available is just over one mile with the limitation clearly shown by boundary markers.

There are plenty of deep holes of three to four feet in depth. Deep bends to the far bank with plenty of overhanging trees and features. There are also some slow mid water runs.

**Remember you must leave the water before dark.**

**No dogs or fires.**

**Do not go near the pond on the farm land as this is not set up for fishing**
